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YEAR 5 - TUDOR WORKSHOP

The Year 5's will experience an immersion into Tudor England (both as a peasant and a royal), led by one of Hampton Courts ladies in waiting (your professional actor workshop facilitator), the students receive a facetime call from Henry VIII and go on a journey to find him a wife! This workshop is focused around creativity, making learning engaging and fun.

- Curriculum-based activities, including Tudor inventories (interactive artefacts) and Tudor truth or lies game.
- Immersive soundscapes and world building through story-telling
- Tudor costumes and props
- Character Creation and role-play using the character cards and missions provided
- Interactive learning ensuring key information is learnt whilst still promoting creativity, collaboration, and play



YEAR 6 - WW2 WORKSHOP



- Physical Interactive Timeline
- A volunteer Winston Churchill!
- Women's role in WWII talk from a professional actor in character
- Soundscapes transporting us back to London in the Blitz- allowing the students to step into the shoes of a WWII evacuee.
- Real WWII Artefacts (Including a Gas Mask)
- Drama Games such as Freeze Frames (tying in with Propaganda)
- Finishing with a character creation improvisation task: each getting a role (eg a code-breaker or an air raid warden) and having to complete a mission.
- Each student is given a replica Ration book to take home with them.

The workshop allows the students become fully engaged and immersed in the topic of World War II. Combining Drama skills with historical knowledge, the experience is designed to be enriching, memorable and fun.

Practical Information

- Length: 1 hour per class
- Each workshop includes a follow-up activity pack (sent digitally)
- Materials provided for each child that can be kept as a souvenir or used for classroom displays.
- Location: We come to your school, meaning no trip logistics or extra costs

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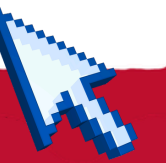
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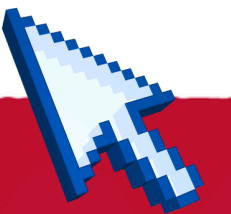
